With reference to the application dated **11.11.2025** and subsequent recommendations of District Educational Officer (Private Schools), **Salem** and school inspection on **11.11.2025** in this regard, I hereby convey the grant of Recognition to **Sri Seshaas International Public School, 9/132, Kondappanaikkanpatti, Salem – 636 008, Tamil Nadu** for the class **PreKG to XII** Standard for the period up to **28.02.2028** in compliance to Rule 12 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and Rules 2011 and maintain the standards and norms as specified in section 19 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.

The Recognition Code Number allotted to the School is 004-17-S-0024-0228

The above recognition is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The temporary recognition accorded to the school is valid up to **28.02.2028** for the classes **PreKG to XII** and is to be renewed at the end of three years.
2. The School shall abide by the provisions of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Tamil Nadu Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011. The School shall maintain the standards and norms as specified in section 19 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.
3. The School shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or parent or guardian to any screening procedure.
4. The School shall not deny admission to any child :-
 - (a) For lack of age proof if such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period prescribed for admission.
 - (b) On the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.
5. The school shall ensure that :-
 - (a) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school.
 - (b) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
 - (c) No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education
 - (d) Inclusion of students with disabilities/ special need as per provision of the Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016.
6. The School shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority
7. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or in any other place in the name of School.
8. The School building plan must have been approved by the competent authorities as per relevant rules. The School building or other structures and the land are to be used only for the purposes of education and skill development. Construction work within the compound should not be carried out in school working hours and safety measures in all respects are the whole responsibility of the school management.
